




#### Central City Multimodal Project


Central City Multimodal Project will help make getting to and around the Central City safer, easier, and more convenient by foot, bike, and transit through planning, prioritizing and constructing active transportation projects



### Identified as a priority for 3 reasons:



- Safety of people walking and biking: 20 of the top 40 high crash intersections for walking and biking are within the project area
- Lack of a bicycle network designed for all ages and abilities in the Central City
- Lack of stakeholder and public clarity on strategy for active transportation improvements in the Central City, particularly for the bike network.






#### **Total Project Budget:**








