## SW Stark & Oak Streets Green Lane Design

The Portland Bureau of Transportation will roll out a new design of the bike lanes on SW Stark and Oak. Color and road markings will help travelers navigate the lanes and get to their destinations.

### Project Goals

- Reduce lane confusion
- Maintain vehicle separation
- Create a more attractive streetscape that accommodates more people using SW Stark and Oak streets.

### Recent Findings

- Drivers and bicycle riders prefer vehicle separation created by the lanes
- More people ride bikes on Stark and Oak because of the bike lanes

### How to Use

- Automobiles may cross the bike lane to turn or park
- The bike lane is a through-lane for bicycles only
- People bicycling should expect turning vehicles crossing the lane
