

Man, 28, Sentenced to Year in Jail on Morals Charge

Leo A. St. Germaine, 28, 4768 NE Alberta St., has been sentenced to a year in county jail in a morals case involving a 15-year-old girl with whom he lived several days in a motel last September. Presiding Circuit Judge Charles W. Redding dealt the jail term on a charge of contributing to the delinquency of a minor. He also placed St. Germaine on probation three years on a statutory rape charge. The district attorney's office recommended dismissal of the latter charge after the defendant pleaded guilty to the contributing count but the judge felt the charge should stand.

Judge Revokes Probation
 An additional year in the state penitentiary was imposed on Excell Walker, 24, on a revocation of probation. He earlier had been sent to prison for 18 months on a burglary charge.

Carl James Bernard, 18, 6594 N. Bowdoin St., received three years probation for burglarizing Finness Garden Supply, 8501 N. Chautauqua Blvd., last month.

Plan Offered for School Crosswalk Problem

City Commissioner William A. Bowes said Wednesday he will recommend six additional changes to ease the Creston School crosswalk problem. The suggested improvements are the result of parental demands for better safeguards at the troublesome SE 47th Ave.-Powell Blvd. intersection. Mothers and fathers turned to using "human chain" tactics to stop traffic on the busy thoroughfares as their children crossed to and from school.

Mrs. Frank Dirks, Creston PTA's safety chairman, said that the suggestions were "excellent so far as handling the problem at a school crossing would be helpful."

The basic problem, she said, was in protecting children and pedestrians when safety patrol members are not at the crossing. She said it appeared that the operation of a push-button light at an unlocked box on both sides of the street would be helpful.

"We are going to take a two-week vacation and look at the problem after the Christmas holidays. These suggestions sound fine, but we are going to wait and see what is actually done," she said.

The Portland Traffic Safety Commission and highway officials approve them.

The improvements, in fact, are the recommendations of the school safety committee of the safety commission. As advanced, they will include:

1. The painting of a yellow line crosswalk at the present crossing used by youngsters going to and from the Creston School.
2. Installation of a standard crosswalk sign ahead of the existing school crossing sign. It will alert motorists to be prepared to stop.
3. Installation of a push-button control on both sides of the street to halt traffic by a red signal when youngsters are waiting to cross.
4. Restrict the operation of the regular three-cycle red, green and amber signal to actuation by the Junior Safety Patrol.
5. Move the present 30-mile-an-hour posted speed sign further east on SE Powell Blvd.
6. Seek agreement with Rose City Transit Co. to change its present bus stop so that it will be farther removed from the actual intersection.
