Broadway Main Street & Supporting Neighborhood Connections

This project will make a generational investment in Lower Albina to support the nation's largest restorative development initiative. These investment will connect key sites in Lower Albina to neighborhoods and key destinations across Interstate 5 to the north and east, while also improving connections within the district to important destinations including the Willamette River, a regional transit center, and both existing and planned parks and open spaces.

The Albina Vision: Broadway Main Street Project will tangibly advance social, economic, and environmental justice by catalyzing necessary transportation infrastructure investment needed in the Albina neighborhood.

Streetscape and safety investments make this busy corridor a more welcoming street for current and future residents. This project compliments and extends the planned investments in the I-5 Rose Quarter cap and local street improvements to better reconnect neighborhoods on either side of the highway.

PROJECT GOALS:

- Main Street redesign to reconnect Albina area to nearby neighborhoods and support future development goals.
- Transform the widest surface arterials in Portland's Central City to a safer, more human-scaled environment.
- Improve safety and access for current and future residents of the Albina area.
- Reimagine N Larrabee Ave with expanded green space, less paved surfaces, and places for people to gather and connect.
- Honor the district's history through public realm elements including public art, urban design, and monumentation.
- Maintain freight access to industrial areas in Lower Albina and Swan Island.
- Advance workforce development and equitable contracting goals to spur job creation and economic opportunities.

PROJECT ELEMENTS:

- Improved sidewalks and safer pedestrian crossings.
- Reduce the distance for people crossing the street from 96ft today to 60ft or less on N Broadway approaching the bridge.
- Improved access to Rose Quarter Transit Center, Portland Streetcar, and other transportation services.
- Additional tree canopy, green infrastructure, street lighting, and other streetscape amenities.
- Upgraded and protected lanes for people biking and scooting.
- Potential for restoration of on-street parking and curbside loading in some areas.



The Broadway Main Street project fully integrates into the Albina Vision Community Investment Plan, supporting equitable development in the district.



A key element of this project is the redesign of the Broadway Bridgehead area along N Larrabee Ave including removal of the slip lane and increased public space for community programming.
