

ORDINANCE No. 189446

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$1,682,468 from the Oregon Department of Transportation and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement for the I-205 Undercrossing Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation applied to Oregon Department of Transportation for a grant in the amount of \$1,682,468 for the I-205 Undercrossing Project in August 2015 and
2. ODOT has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the design and construction of bicycle and pedestrian improvements along the I-205 Undercrossing segment of the Tillamook-Holladay-Oregon-Pacific Neighborhood Greenway to the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$1,682,468;
3. The I-205 Undercrossing Project is funded and programmed as part of the 2018-2021 STIP cycle.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the design and construction of bicycle and pedestrian improvements along the I-205 Undercrossing segment of the Tillamook-Holladay-Oregon-Pacific Neighborhood Greenway in the amount of \$1,682,468 and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
